Frequently asked Questions:

What is Mayuri's Meals package?

It is a concept derived from both Carriage meals and Monthly mess tickets facility available in Restaurants back in India.

Why package prices are less than Regular price?

As we will know the number of meals we have to prepare way ahead, We cook exact quantities and avoid food wastage.

How many meals this package is equivalent to.

This is designed for folks who eat Indian food regularly at home.

We assume rice is prepared at home and we will give 10 chapathis which may be used immediately for the first 3 or 4 meals.

A typical Regular meal a person consumes in ozs (1 oz = 30 ml) is as below:

- Chapathi or Rice (or both)
- 3-4 oz of Curry one
- 3-4 oz of Curry two
- 2-3 oz Rasam or Sambar
- 2-3 oz of Yogurt.

In veg package we give 4 curries which totals to 64 oz and Rasam 16 oz and Yogurt 16 oz.

So One Veg Meals package is equivalent to at least 8 meals costing \$5 per meal.

and similarly \$6 per non-veg meal.

Minimum how many Meal packages we need to buy and in how many days we need to use them?

Similar to monthly tickets concept You need to commit to this program by buying minimum 5 meal package tickets At a time (roughly equivalent to 8@5 = 40 meals) and use them within a month by redeeming only One meals package ticket per visit (roughly equivalent to 8 meals).

Are these packages available for pickup every day?

As we need some planning these packages are only available on Sunday and Wednesday from 3:00 pm to 10:00 PM.

Do we need to tell you when we will pick up my package?

Yes for planning purposes if you are picking up on Sunday you need to reserve your package 4 days before that is by Wednesday 8:00 PM. If you are picking up on Wednesday you need to reserve your package 3 days before i.e. by Sunday 8:00 PM.
